The signs may be returned anonymously to the front door of City Hall during business hours or after hours. If anyone returns the stolen signs within this twenty-four hour period, no questions will be asked.

If the stolen signs are not returned within the twenty-four hour period, the City will take the necessary steps to determine the identity of the person or persons who stole the signs. Steps included will be reviewing video cameras from numerous locations. Return of the signs will prevent prosecution.
