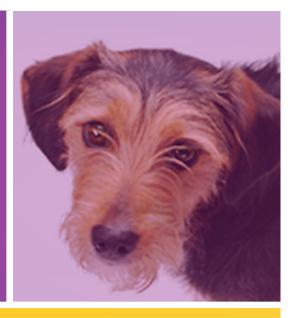
Lost pet? Surrendering your pet? Find an injured animal?

If you **lost your pet,** call (727) 582-2600 or go to **Pinellas County Animal Services**, 12450 Ulmerton Road, Largo. If you **find a healthy or injured, stray dog or cat**, take them to **Pinellas County**

Animal Services, or call (727) 582-2600.

If you're able to **Care for the stray** cat or dog, notify **Pinellas County Animal Services** at (727) 582-2600.

Lost pets will be listed on *www.pinellascounty.org/animalservices*.

If you find an **injured stray animal** (pig, rabbit or ferret), or **injured wildlife** (squirrel, owl or raccoon), take them to **SPCA Tampa Bay.** Animal transport services will be provided by SPCA Tampa Bay.
