	Notices and Regulations	

- 1. All persons shall recognize that skateboarding, inline skating, and roller skating are inherently dangerous and risky activities which may result in injury or damage to persons or properties. All persons engaging in such activities shall recognize that they must know their own abilities and that they will be skating at their own risk.
- 2 A valid permit/decal shall be necessary for skating in the skate facility for anyone under the age of 17 years. The permit/decal MUST be displayed on their helmet.
- 3. Anyone under the age of 17 years may not engage in any skateboarding, inline skating, and skating until the governmental entity has obtained written consent, in a form acceptable to the governmental entity, from the child's parents and/or legal guardians as per F.S. 316.0085.
- 4. Persons under the age of 17 found skating or possessing skate equipment inside the Skate Facility without a valid permit shall be considered trespassers. Spectators who are not skating and do not possess skate equipment may enter without a permit but shall be subject to the same rules of conduct as permit holders.
- 5. Allowable skate equipment shall be limited to:
  - a. Skateboards
  - b. Roller Blades
  - c. Roller Skates
  - d. Scooters (*self-propelled*)

Other equipment, such as bicycles and scooters, is specifically prohibited in the facility.

- 6. The skate facility may only be used during posted hours of operation.
- 7. The skate facility shall be closed when it is raining and when ramp surfaces are wet.
- 8. The skate facility may not be used by the general public when reserved for a special recreational program, or when a special time period has been designated for beginners or special age categories.
- 9. The following is prohibited within and around the vicinity of the skate facility:
  - a. Food and beverages (except in designated areas)
  - b. Glass containers
  - c. Smoking
  - d. Profanity

- e. Amplified sound including but not limited to radios and cassette/CD players. Radios, tape/CD players and similar audio equipment may be used when the sound is limited to headsets.
- f. Ramp or obstacle equipment not provided by the City.
- g. Moving obstacle or other equipment.
- h. Waxing skateboards or other equipment on City premises.
- i. Unnecessary noise.
- j. Chewing gum or tobacco.
- k. Climbing fences.
- 1. Graffiti, stickers, posters or defacing property.
- m. Skateboarding is prohibited on the tennis, basketball and/or racquetball/handball courts.
- n. Non-skaters are prohibited from sitting on obstacles within the facility.
- o. Bicycles.
- 12. Users of the skate facility shall immediately comply with any instructions given by City staff, code enforcement officer or law enforcement officers.
- 13. Violation of any rules of the skate facility may result in the revocation of a skate facility permit.
- 14. The Pinellas County Sheriff's Office is authorized to enforce the provisions of the ordinance by issuing a trespass notice for violators of posted regulations.
- 15. A \$5.00 charge will be assessed for replacing lost or damaged permits.
